

## **Ellis Park Wagering & Payout Rules Super High Five (SH5)**

### **Super High Five (SH5)**

- The object of the Super High-Five Pool (or SH5) is the selection of the first five (5) finishers, in their exact order, for a single contest. Unless otherwise stated, the net SH5 pool shall be distributed as a single-priced pool to those who have selected all five (5) finishers, in exact order, in a specified number of positions (5) in the SH5 pool, based upon the official order to finish.
- Carryover: If there are no winning wagers selecting all five (5) finishers, in exact positions, the SH5 pool shall be added to the carryover.
- Scratches: If due to a late scratch, the number of betting interests in the SH5 contest pool is reduced to fewer than seven (7), for the purpose of the SH5 pool only, such contest shall be declared a “No Contest” and the SH5 pool shall be subject to a refund, but not the SH5 carryover pool.
- Should a betting interest in the SH5 pool be scratched or excused from the contest, no more wagers shall be accepted selecting that scratched contestant and all tickets previously sold designating such horse shall be refunded and that money deducted from the gross pool.
- Dead Heats: In the event of a dead heat in the SH5, based upon the official order of finish, each share of the net SH5 pool shall be distributed as a single-priced pool regardless of dead heats. For the purposes of determining whether a wager correctly selected the finishers in exact position, contestants in a dead heat are deemed to jointly occupy both or all positions in the dead heat. For example, if 5 and 6 dead heat for first, then a selection of 5, for either first or second is correct, and a selection of 6, for either first or second is also correct.
- If, on the final day there are no wagers selecting the most finishers, (5) in the correct order of finish, then the SH5 pool and carryover shall be distributed as a single-priced pool to those who correctly selected the “next most” finishers (4) etc., in their exact positions, in the SH5 contest, based upon the official order of finish.
